- Adult black belt kata divisions 73 & 81, competitor must be 16 years or older.
- Kumite will use WKF rules with the following modifications:

 - o Juniors 17 and under, non-advanced. Head contact must be penalized
 - o Juniors 15-17 Advanced Hand contact to head will not score
 - o Adults (except WKF divisions) 2 minutes stop time, 8 point ceiling
- All weapons will be subject to inspection by judges before competition. Modified weapons or weapons that do not meet tournament criteria may not be used in competition. Weapons must remain in the competitor's hands at all times. Loss of control will result in disqualification.

Adults (except WKF divisions)	2 minutes stop time, 8 point ceiling

All weapons will be subject to inspection by judges before competition. Modified weapons or weapons that do not meet tournament criteria may not be used in competition. 6 ft. Bo must weigh at least 900 grams. Weapons must remain in the competitor's hands at all times. Loss of control will result in disqualification.
